- Noah was righteous (by faith) (Gen 6:9, Hebrews 11:7)
- Noah was blameless/Integrity
- Noah walked with God (lived for, obeyed)
- Did all that God commanded (Gen 6:22, 7:5)
- Noah sacrificed to the Lord (Gen. 8:20-22)
- Reverently prepared the ark (Heb. 11:7)

What was the outcome?

Preserved, when all others not spared (2 Peter 2:5)

In what ways did / did not they Fear the Lord?

- Partially obeys the Lord to move, taking Lot and His wife (Genesis 12:4-5)
- Fears the Egyptians, profits initially over his omission (Genesis 12:10-20)
- + Fights for the life of Lot (Genesis 14:13-16)
- Has child with Hagar (Genesis 16:1)
 - **Note after the promise of his own heir from God (Gen. 15)
- + Circumcision (Genesis 17:10-27)
- Negotiating Lot's rescue from Sodom destruction (Gen. 18)
- Fears and lies to Abimelech like Pharaoh (Genesis 20)
- Offering of Isaac (Genesis 22, v16, Hebrews 11:17-19)

What was the outcome?

- Brought trouble to himself, his family, and his neighbors
- A father of many nations (Romans 4:9-25)
- Genesis 25:8 Abraham breathed his last and died in a ripe old age, an old man and satisfied with life; and he was gathered to his people.

Application:

- Recognize when the fear of God is eclipsed by the fear of man, we are risk in the trial to give into temptation. (1 Corinthians 10:13, 31)

- Jacob (no fear) / Esau (fear): Selling of the Birthright (Genesis 25:27-34)
 - Others see this kind of fear, they will convince you to give something up for a sense of temporary security
- Jacob Fears & lies to Abimelech (not same person) like his Dad (Genesis 26:7-11)
- Esau marries two wives (Genesis 26:34-35)
- Jacob Deceives Dad & steals Esau's blessing w/ Mom's prompting (+40 years old) (Genesis 27)
- Esau out of spite marries daughter of Ishmael (Genesis 28:8-9)
- +/- Jacob's ladder dream (Genesis 28:10-22)
- Multiples Marriages, Mayhem, Mandrakes and Many Kids (13)! (Genesis 29-30)
- + / Jacob's Deception with Laban (Genesis 30:25-31:16) / Genesis 31:11-13
- + / Jacob flees from Laban (Genesis 31:3, 16-21)
- + / Jacob fears Esau (after 20 years) (Genesis 32:1) Note: angels of God (Gen. 32:1)
- / Jacob wrestles with God (Genesis 32:24-32)
- +/- Jacob Reconciles with Esau (Genesis 33:1-17)



- + Bad report (Gen. 37:3)
- + Told the Dreams (Gen. 37:5-11)
- Brother's Hatred / Jealousy (Bad Report, Dad's favoritism, Tunic, Two Dreams, Checking up on them, sold Joseph into slavery)
- + Joseph serves Potiphar (Gen. 39:1-18) Key Verse Gen. 39:9-12
- + Joseph serves in the prison (Gen. 39:19-40:23)
- Pharaoh Dreams (Genesis 41) + Joseph's Response Key Verse (Genesis 41:16)
 - * Note: Joseph an innocent slave for 13 years
- -People did not prepare (Genesis 41:53-47, 47:13-26)
- Joseph's Brothers (Genesis 42-46, Genesis 50:15-21) Key Verse: Gen. 44:34

What was the outcome?

- Egyptians enslaved to Pharaoh, except the priests
- Israel Preserved
- Brothers lived with guilt and sin, even after being forgiven
- Joseph blessed and exalted

In what ways did / did not they Fear the Lord?

- Killed the Egyptian (Exodus 2:11-14)
- Angel of the Lord Appeared and Spoke in the Burning Bush (Exodus 3:1-6)
- Fled from the Staff turned into a Snake (Exodus 4:1-3)
- Speech problem? (Exodus 4:10-17) (Note: God became angry (Exodus 4:14)
- Son (s) not circumcised (Exodus 4:24-26)
- Pharaoh Rejects the request and makes Israel gather their own straw (Exodus 5)
- Israel is afraid and angry (Exodus 5:22-23, Exodus 6:9,
- Pharaoh's heart hardened by Himself /stubborn and later hardened by God
 - Exodus 7:8-13 Staff-Snake (Magicians Copy)
 - 1. Exodus 7:14-22 water to blood (Magicians Copy)
 - 2. Exodus 8:1-15 Frogs / Entreats until relief (Magicians Copy)
 - 3. Exodus 8:16-19 Gnats (Magicians could not copy)
 - 4. Exodus 8:20-32 Flies with Separation (go, but not very far away)
 - 5. Exodus 9:1-7 Pestilence kills the livestock with separation
 - 6. Exodus 9:8-12 Boils
 - 7. Exodus 9:18-34/35 Hail
 - 8. Exodus 10:1-20 Locusts (only the men can go, Pharaoh's servants plead)
 - 9. Exodus 10:21-27/29 Darkness
 - 10. Exodus 11-12:32 Death of the first born

- Pharaoh chased (Exodus 14:4, 5, 8, 17 and was drowned Exodus 14:26-29)
